I currently have four students in the classroom and all are non-verbal. These buttons will give the non-verbal students the chance to communication throughout the day on all activities of school environment. These buttons are large enough that they can push the button with minimal physical support yet small enough where they can take them to their elective class to utilize. We use them daily during math instruction when students are counting objects.

Results:

These recordable communication buttons have been fantastic! Students are interacting more independently throughout their school environment, socializing with their friends more, and answering academic questions with more confidence.
